## Additional guidelines and conditions

### Covid-19

1. The UK government has lifted all Covid-19 restrictions. This means that face coverings are no longer mandatory in public spaces, including on public transport. There is some guidance issued on what to do if you test positive for Covid-19. You can read the current guidance here:

2. In line with national guidance, the University of Oxford has also removed all Covid-19 restrictions. The University asks that staff and students:
  - avoid contact with others if you might be infectious
  - respect other people's space
  - let fresh air in when indoors
  - keep up to date with COVID vaccinations
  - respect those who choose to wear a face covering
  - cover coughs and sneezes and wash your hands regularly

3. If you experience any Covid-19 symptoms during the programme, please stay at your accommodation and advise the Programme Administrators as soon as possible. They will do their best to support you with access to testing, and any items or services you might require. Please note that the programme cannot cover any additional costs that might be incurred in this respect.
4. Note that the programme is not set up for hybrid participation, and therefore if you become unwell you will not be able to join the sessions online.

### Accommodation and incidentals

1. Your accommodation is booked for you at the locations confirmed by the Programme Administrators, from Saturday 2 July – Friday 15 July. Check-out is on Friday 15 July by 12:00pm.
2. If you have arranged extra nights of accommodation at either venue, you must settle the account directly with the accommodation provider. You must

also settle all incidentals directly with the accommodation provider before your departure.

3. The Blavatnik School cannot provide for any extra nights of accommodation, including for the cost of extra nights incurred through delayed or cancelled transport, illness (including Covid-19), or otherwise.

### Insurance

1. The Blavatnik School recommends that all programme participants arrange for comprehensive travel insurance before travelling to Oxford.
